

# Dunragit - The Prehistoric Heart of Galloway

This talk covers extensive archaeological excavations that took place along the road line of a new bypass around Dunragit in Dumfries & Galloway. The road and excavation weaved their way around likely Neolithic ceremonial complexes, and revealed findings dating back over 9,000 years. They included archaeology from the Mesolithic, Neolithic, Bronze Age and Iron Ages, including further Neolithic ceremonial landscape features, a Bronze Age funerary complex and settlement activity from each period.
