Oxford Cotswold Archaeology's (OCA) excavation of Thame Meadows unearthed 6000 years of archaeology including a fantastic array of monuments of funerary and ceremonial importance. Ranging from Early Neolithic (3700-3500 BC) to the Late Saxon periods (10th/11th centuries AD) periods it additionally revealed features connected with settlement, industry and mortuary practices and is by far the most significant site, to be investigated in the Thame valley.
