

Mesolithic hunter-gatherers of the Kennet valley

Wednesday 20th March 2024 at 8 pm (Note change of weekday) by Zoom
Professor Martin Bell, University of Reading

The talk will review the hunter-gather archaeology of the Kennet valley, including our Ufton Bridge 2023 excavation. Ufton is an early Mesolithic camp on a gravel rise in the Kennet floodplain. Excavation revealed a well-preserved horizon with flint tools, waste from tool production and bones.

An early Bronze Age palaeochannel of the Kennet produced pottery, many beaver bones, peat, tufa (spring chalk) and organic silts preserve pollen, plant evidence for the Mesolithic and Bronze Age environment.
